**URGENT MEDICINE RECALL**

We hereby inform you that we are recalling the following batch of Lethyl 30 mg Tablets:

This recall is initiated as a result of a product quality complaint logged with Aspen Pharmacare due to the discoloration of Lethyl 30 mg Tablets. During the investigation of the complaint, additional samples obtained within the market were subjected to testing and OOS (Out-of-Specification) microbiological results identified the presence of two organisms on the tablets i.e. *Penicillium spp.* and *Chaetomium spp.*

We request that you immediately return the affected batch of Lethyl 30 mg to your supplying wholesaler or distributor for full credit.
